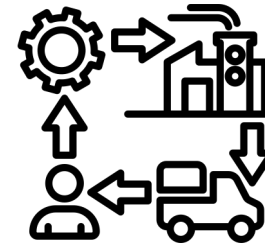
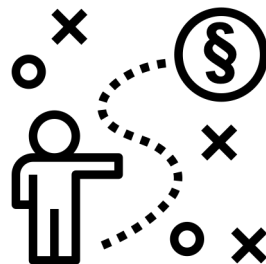

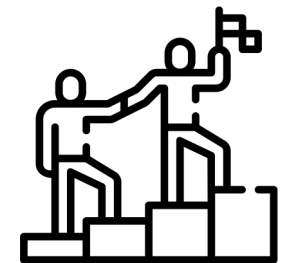

What is IIOm?

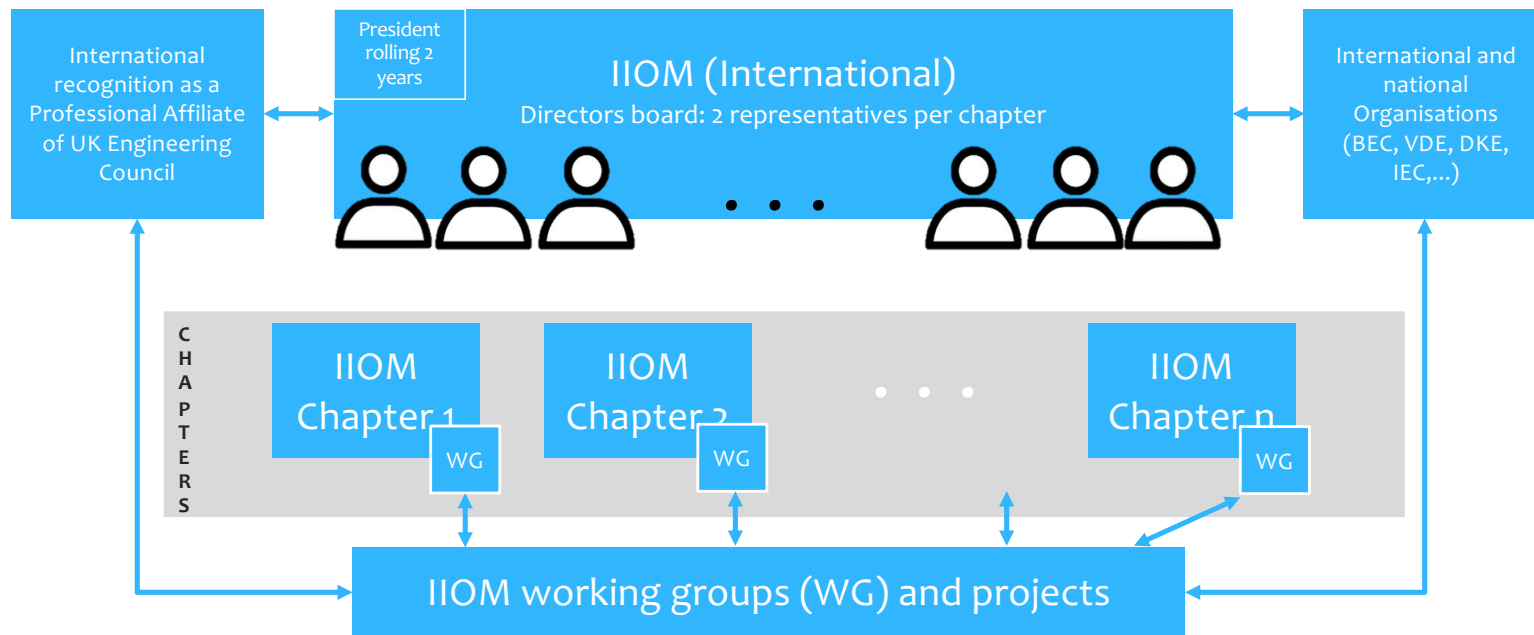
- * The International Institute of Obsolescence Management (IIOm) is a not for profit organisation that promotes the discipline of obsolescence management
- * Individual and Corporate members join IIOm Chapters; each Chapter is affiliated to IIOm
- * It is a professional body for individuals who want to further their knowledge and understanding of obsolescence management, and want to have their competence formally recognised
- * Corporate members can be private or public companies, government organisations, research establishments and obsolescence solution providers that wish to work together to improve the management of obsolescence



IOM Mission

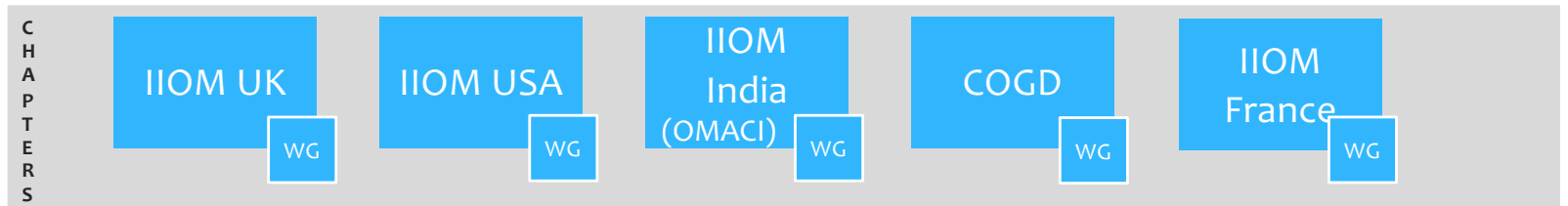
- * Advance the science and practice of Obsolescence Management
- * Promote and recognise high standards of practice and professional competence
- * Provide opportunities for development, and career paths for practitioners of Obsolescence Management
- * Increase awareness and understanding of the discipline
- * Support the growth of specialist Obsolescence Management service providers affiliated to IOM

Equal rights for each Chapter within the organisation

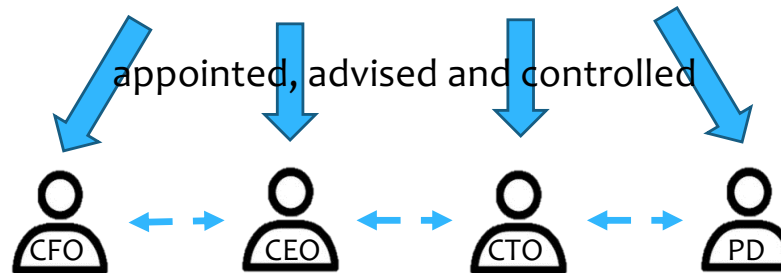
The Iiom structure – operational structure

IOM International

- * IOM International is a not-for-profit organisation established in the UK
- * Each IOM Chapter is linked to IOM International by a Delegation Agreement
- * Each IOM Chapter appoints two people as Directors of IOM, usually the Chair and one other person from the Chapter organising committee
 - * The President and Vice-President are directors of IOM and appointed by the IOM Board for a term of 2 years, linked to the cycle of the International Conference
 - * The Chief Technical Officer (CTO) is a paid position
- * IOM is specifically responsible for
 - * Organising the International Conference
 - * Professional Development – IOM is a Professional Affiliate of the Engineering Council
 - * Approval and audit of training providers
 - * International Website, IOM Wiki page (in progress) and other social media such as LinkedIn and YouTube
 - * Working parties to support obsolescence management developments such as smartPCN
 - * Supporting the setting up of new Chapters

IOM Membership

- * IOM membership worldwide is more than 250 companies including:
 - * Component manufacturers and distributors
 - * OEMs from aerospace, automotive medical, military, nuclear, oil exploration, rail and telecoms sectors
 - * Government and industry organisations
 - * Aftermarket suppliers
 - * Obsolescence management tool providers
 - * Consultancy and Project Management companies
 - * Asset owners, operators and maintainers
- * Members in more than twelve countries.
- * Five Chapters, more than 250 companies, and more than 700 individuals as a community
 - * Individuals can be company representatives or join as individuals

IIOM Chapters

IIOM Chapters

- * Each IIOM Chapter is an independent not-for-profit organisation that covers a territory, either a country or group of countries such as DACH region
- * The Chapter can either be
 - * An existing organisation that would like to be affiliated to IIOM (e.g. COGD, IFO), keeping its own name, or
 - * A new organisation set up with the support of IIOM (e.g. IIOM India, IIOM USA)
- * The Chapter manages
 - * Its own programme of events – meetings, seminars etc.
 - * Its own finances (which are independent of IIOM)
 - * Its own website and other promotional activities
 - * Its membership, and sets the annual fees for membership
- * Each Chapter is linked to IIOM by a Delegation Agreement that describes the rights and responsibilities of each party

IIOM Chapters

- * IIOM has five Chapters
 - * France
 - * Germany (territory includes Austria and Switzerland)
 - * India
 - * United Kingdom
 - * United States of America
- * Any individual or company from any country can join their local IIOM Chapter
 - * UK Chapter is the default chapter for members in countries not covered by their own chapter
- * When there is a “critical mass” of members in a country without a local chapter, discussions to set up a Chapter can begin; support to set up a Chapter is provided
- * IIOM is holding discussions in several countries/territories including Australia, Benelux, Italy & South Korea.

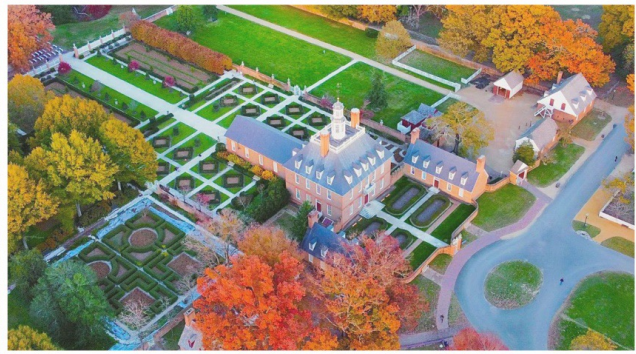
